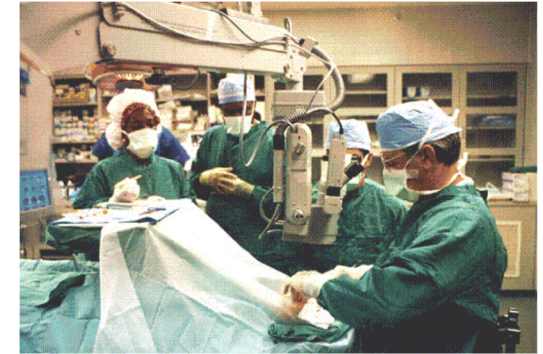


What can I do with Anatomy/Physiology?

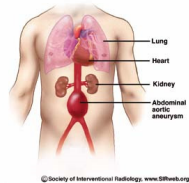

What is Anatomy/Physiology?



Students investigate the structure and function of the human body including: a comparison of the anatomical structures

and physiological functions of human systems, integration of the body's reproduction, growth, and development processes, relation of the body's energy needs to its energy supplying processes, maintenance of homeostasis within the body while responding to internal and external forces, and environmental factors that affect the human body.

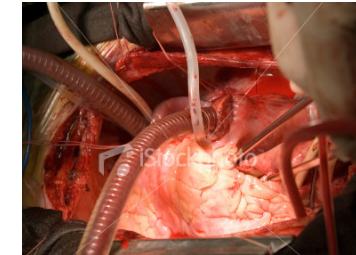
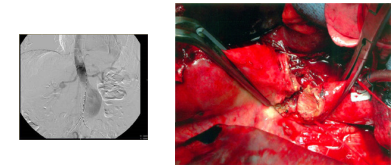
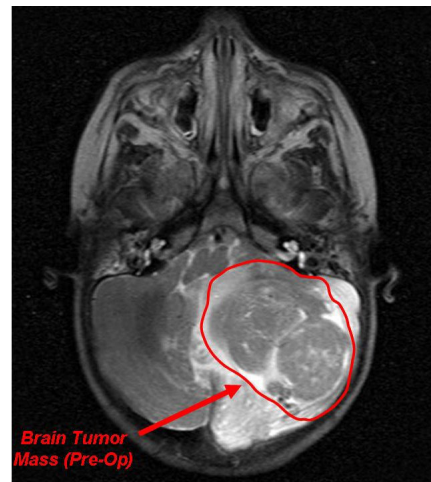
