HOW DO STUDENTS ENROLL IN AVID?

Students must complete an application and interview process in order to be accepted into AVID. Students cannot be placed in AVID. See your AVID Campus Coordinator for details.

RIGOROUS COURSES REQUIREMENT

AVID students must take at least one Advanced Academics course: PAP, AP, Dual Credit or On Ramps. AVID students cannot drop their advanced courses or AVID without first consulting the AVID Coordinator.
